Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) hereby provides notification that mobilization for the Main Installation Remedial Action (MIRA) has begun. The primary MIRA construction activity will be installation of injection and monitoring wells. The drilling subcontractor, Prosonic Corporation, will mobilized equipment and personnel from their Memphis office on May 1, 2006. Drilling is to begin May 3, 2006. In addition, construction of the trailer-mounted injection system by INTEX Environmental has begun at their facility in Pennsylvania and renovations to the lactate storage-transfer facility (Building 265) by Jones Brothers, Inc. will begin in mid-May.
