Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) hereby provides notification that mobilization for the Source Areas Remedial Action (RA) has been completed. The Source Areas RA is being performed in a phased approach. The initial phase is construction of the Fluvial Soil Vapor Extraction (SVE) system. The following phases will be limited excavation, transport and disposal; construction and operation of thermal-enhanced SVE in the loess; and zero valent iron injection in groundwater. The drilling subcontractor for the SVE wells, Prosonic Corporation, mobilized equipment and personnel from their Memphis office on May 14, 2007 and drilling began that same day. In addition, construction of the SVE system controls and treatment compound by Onion Equipment Company has begun at their facility in Indiana. Construction of the treatment compound pad and electrical hook-up will be performed by Jones Brothers, Inc. in late May.
