Subject: Notification of Cessation of Work - TA-3, Dunn Field

Dear Sirs:

In accordance with Section XXVIII.D of the Federal Facilities Agreement for the Former Defense Depot Memphis Tennessee (DDMT), DLA hereby notifies you of a cessation of work at Dunn Field. On December 13, 2007, contractors working on behalf of DLA encountered two metallic objects resembling bomb casings while working within TA-3 of Dunn Field. One casing was crushed, and one casing appeared to be intact. The contractors immediately stopped work at the site and notified DLA of the findings. Workers followed the health and safety plan by evacuating the excavation area.

DLA is working with the U.S. Army to determine follow-up actions and will notify EPA and TDEC of those actions once they are determined.
