Dear Mr. Dobbs:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed the subject document. EPA comments on the Rev. 0 document were satisfactorily addressed. EPA hereby approves it as final.

There are two areas where the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) may wish to make changes before finalizing. In Section 4.5, the interim Remedial Action Completion Report should include a summary of the activities taken to implement the land use controls (LUC) element of the Dunn Field remedy. Documenting LUC implementation is part of documenting RA completion.. Also, in Section 5.0, DLA may want to clarify that the contingency for ground water outside (down-gradient) of the treatment zone refers to water that has passed through the treatment zone, and not to ground water in excess of 50 ug/L that is beyond its influence at the start of treatment. That is the area slated for monitored natural attenuation. If you have any questions, please contact me at 404/562-8553.
