Dear Mr. Levy:

The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) have reviewed Fort McClellan's submittal of the *Final Site Investigation Report for the CBR Proficiency Area, Parcel 517(7)*. During the Base Realignment and Closure Team (BCT) meeting on April 16, 2002, the Department presented comments on the report to the Army and BCT stakeholders in order to resolve the Department's comments. The Army recommended a No Further Action (NFA) and unrestricted land reuse designation for Parcel 517(7).

Based on Fort McClellan's analytical data, the Department concurs that the limited number of exceedences of various contaminant levels in site media are of insufficient magnitude to pose a potential threat to human and ecological receptors at Parcel 517(7). Although anthropogenic compounds were present at levels significantly higher than ecological screening values (ESVs), there are no relevant ecological receptors on the site and the area is primarily paved. Therefore, ADEM concurs that ecological concerns are not relevant to this parcel.

The Department concurs with Fort McClellan's recommendation that Parcel 517(7) be designated as No Further Action and unrestricted reuse.

The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) have reviewed Fort McClellan's submittal of the *Final Site Investigation (SI) Report for the CBR Proficiency Area, Parcel 517(7)*.

The Chemical, Biological, and Radiological (CBR) Proficiency Area covers approximately 4.5 acres and is located in the Cantonment Area at Fort McClellan.
