Dear Mr. Levy:

The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) has reviewed the Army's submittal of the *Final Site Investigation Report and Decision Document for the Former Rifle/Machine Gun Range, Parcel 99Q*.

The Department understands that Parcel 99Q is partially located in both the Alpha and Charlie areas at Fort McClellan. At this time UXO matters remain unresolved at this parcel and will be addressed during ADEM's review of the Alpha and Charlie area EE/CA workplans and reports for these areas.

Based on the Army's reported analytical data and its demonstration that any potential risks to human and ecological receptors are within acceptable limits, the Department concurs with Fort McClellan's recommendation that Parcel 99Q be designated as NFA with unrestricted land reuse.
