Personally appeared before me Phillip A. Sanguinetti, who being duly sworn, makes oath that he is President of THE ANNISTON STAR, a daily newspaper published in Anniston, Alabama, and that the attached notice ran as follows:

The United States Army intends to sign a Finding of Suitability to Transfer (FOST) for the transfer of approximately 266.40 acres of land and nine facilities located on the western boundary of the Main Post of Fort McClellan in the immediate vicinity of Summerall Gate and extending to the east, south, and northeast. The FOST describes the environmental condition of the property known as the Eastern Bypass-Eastern Portion of Tract No. 3 that is being prepared for transfer to the Alabama Department of Transportation. There were three remediation sites comprising approximately 4 acres located on the property: the Skeet Range, Parcel 69Q; Range 12, Parcel 70Q; and Range 13, Parcel 71Q. These ranges are part of the Iron Mountain Road Ranges, a series of former weapons firing ranges located along Iron Mountain Road. Soils on these ranges were contaminated with lead and other metals associated with small arms ammunition. Based on the results of the removal action performed at the ranges, lead contaminated soil within the property was removed to levels below the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) industrial cleanup level. A decision document titled Portions of Iron Mountain Road Ranges on ALDOT Eastern Bypass Corridor Property, dated June 2006, presenting the determination that land use controls are required to ensure there is no residential use or development on the property has been prepared. Copies of the FOST and the decision document are

available for public review at the Anniston Calhoun County Library on the 1st Floor, 108 E. 10th Street, Anniston, AL 36201, and the Houston Cole Library on the 9th Floor, Jacksonville State University, 700 Pelham Rd, Jacksonville, AL 36265. Public comments on the FOST and the decision document will be accepted until May 25, 2007.
