The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) has reviewed the McClellan Development Authority's (MDA) subject document. Based on this review, ADEM has determined that all comments have been resolved. Therefore, ADEM concurs with the overall content of the subject document.

As recommended in the *CMER* (dated August 2020), MDA should continue with the approved groundwater remedy (monitored natural attenuation along with an environmental covenant restricting groundwater use) at this time. However, if future groundwater monitoring events indicate that contaminant concentrations are not decreasing or indicate an increasing trend, MDA may need to evaluate the need for additional or alternate corrective actions, which could include an investigation to locate any residual contaminant sources that may be present at the site.
