The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) has completed its review of the McClellan Development Authority's (MDA) *Corrective Measures Effectiveness Report (CMER), September 2021 to March 2022 Monitoring Events Training Area T-6 (Naylor Field), Parcel 183(6) and Cane Creek Training Area, Parcel 510(7)*. Based on this review, it appears that two of the five corrective action constituents of concern (COCs) and one degradation product exceeded the risk-based target levels (RBTLs) for groundwater during the sampling events. Monitoring wells CWM-183-MW09, MW13, MW20 and MW23 were the only wells to exceed RBTLs for the COCs. Eight wells exceeded the RBTL for the degradation product vinyl chloride. ADEM concurs with the subject CMER and MDA's recommendation for continued semi-annual groundwater monitoring.
