c. DOD Manual 6055.09-M, Ammunition and Explosives Safety Standards, 29 Feb 08, administratively reissued August 4, 2010.

2. This office has reviewed the subject amendment as requested by reference 1.a, granted Army level approval and forwarded it via reference 1.b, to the Department of Defense Explosives Safety Board (DDESB) for final approval. You may implement this amendment upon receipt of this memorandum, without waiting for final approval, in accordance with paragraph V7.E4.5.1.2 of reference 1.c, which allows a munitions response to proceed prior to final approval if circumstances dictate. This interim approval is based on the need to continue the project without interruption to avoid the cost and loss of time to the Army if the contractor has to demobilize while waiting for final approval. Bear in mind that by implementing the ESS prior to the DDESB final approval, the Army is accepting responsibility for any additional requirements that the DDESB may impose.
