Dear Mr. Scott:

The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) has reviewed the McClellan Development Authority's (MDA) *Remedy Selection Update/Addendum to Final Corrective Measures Implementation Plan (CMIP) Training Area T-6 (Naylor Field), Parcel 183(6) and Cane Creek Training Area, Parcel 510(7)*. The original remedy at the site consisted of air sparging/soil vapor extraction (AS/SVE). In accordance with the Final CMIP, the remedy transitioned from AS/SVE to in-situ bioremediation (ISB). The original round of ISB injections took place in January 2015 and was effective in reducing concentrations of site-related chlorinated volatile organic compounds; however, three monitoring wells, CWM-183-MW07, CWM-183-MW09 and CWM-183-MW23 did not respond to treatment. The subject *Remedy Selection Update/Addendum to Final CMIP* describes additional ISB treatment that will be implemented at these three wells. The document states that groundwater will be sampled on a quarterly basis for one year, semiannually for the second year and then MDA will recommend a sampling frequency to ADEM for incorporation into the Cleanup Agreement after assessing the performance of the treatment. Please note that the sampling frequency after Year 2 will be listed as semi-annual in the forthcoming modification of the Cleanup Agreement until MDA submits a formal request to the Department to change the frequency or until ADEM determines that the sampling frequency is not adequate. The Department concurs with the subject *Remedy Selection Update/Addendum to the Final CMIP*.
