Dear Mr. Cobb:

The Department of the Army (DA) entered into a Land Use Control Assurance Plan (LUCAP) for Fort McClellan on December 12, 2000. On February 28, 2005, the DA transferred responsibility for a portion of Fort McClellan to the National Guard Bureau (NGB) via a Department of Defense Form 1354 (Transfer and Acceptance of Military Real Property). This property is called the Fort McClellan Army National Guard Training Center.

The NGB is currently responsible for the Former Waste Chemical Storage Area (Parcel 87(4)), which is one of several sites at Fort McClellan where Land Use Controls (LUCs) are being used to protect human health and the environment. This letter transmits the annual report, required by the LUCAP, and affirms that LUCs on the Former Waste Chemical Storage Area (Parcel 87(4)) have been effective in protecting human health and safety. Appendix A to the LUCAP (enclosure 1) includes the site where NGB is responsible for monitoring LUCs. The Memorandum for Record (enclosure 2) describes the condition of the Former Waste Chemical Storage Area. The concrete slab at former Building 598 has not been disturbed or altered since the last reporting period. Appendix D (enclosure 3) of the LUCAP lists agency points of contact; it has been updated with a new NGB contact.

## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Inspection of the Former Waste Chemical Storage Area Parcel 87(4)

- 1. The Former Waste Chemical Storage Area, Parcel 87 (4) is located on former Fort McClellan property which is now the Alabama Army National Guard enclave area. The physical location of the storage area is the southeast corner of the National Guard enclave on the west side of Seaton Drive, just beyond the fenced compound.
- 2. The Parcel has high levels of Arsenic in the soil under the concrete slab therefore, Land Use Controls (LUC) have been established for the site in accordance with the Land Use Control Implementation Plan (LUCIP). The LUC purpose is for the protection of human health, the environment and to promote human safety.
- 3. Part of the LUC requirements is to inspect the site at least annually to insure that the land use controls are still effective. An inspection was conducted during the morning of 25 March 2005 and it was observed that no disturbances have been made to the site and the concrete slab is in place and intact.
