The United States Army signed an Action Memorandum on May 18, 2009, to document the selected munitions response action to address munitions and explosives of concern (MEC) on a 10.07 acre parcel of property located on Fort McClellan, Alabama, known as the Iron Mountain Road Addition. The selected response action described in the Action Memorandum is based on the July 2008 Engineering Evaluation and Cost Analysis (EE/CA) and input from stakeholders. As a result of the comprehensive evaluation of alternatives presented in the EE/CA, Construction Support was selected as the most appropriate response action for the area.
