Notice of Intent

The U.S. Army intends to sign an "action memorandum" that describes a course of action to address the potential hazard of ordinance and explosives at the M2 Parcel of land at Fort McClellan. The Army has prepared an engineering evaluation/cost analysis (EE/CA) for the property. This EE/CA characterizes the potential hazard, evaluates alternative courses of action, and recommends an alternative for implementation. Copies of the EE/CA document will be available starting April 10, 2000 for a 30-day public review at the Anniston, AL 36201 and at the Houston Cole Library on the 9th Floor, Jacksonville State University, 700 Pelham Road, Jacksonville, AL 36265. Public comments about the document will be accepted until May 9, 2000.
