
Dear Mr. Coker:

This letter discusses the manner in which Shaw will respond to comments from the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on the subject document. Please note that the proposed field activities for this site were discussed and approved by the BCT at the May 2002 project team meeting. In letters dated March 28, 2003, and September 11, 2002, ADEM and EPA, respectively, issued comments on the August 2002 draft-final work plan after field activities were initiated or completed.

Rather than issuing another iteration of a work plan for work that has already been completed, Shaw will respond to ADEM and EPA comments within the variance section of the Draft Site Investigation Report. This documentation will cost-effectively demonstrate compliance with BCT requirements and will save the Army and regulators from reviewing an additional unnecessary work plan.
