Dear Mr. Levy:

The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) has reviewed the above referenced document. Draft findings related to the subject document were discussed at the Base Realignment and Closure Team (BCT) review meeting on December 5, 2001. During the meeting, the Department provided its comments on these sites in an interactive manner such that the Army and BCT stakeholders could jointly resolve the Department's comments. The Department concurs with Fort McClellan's proposed Plan for conducting a Site Investigation of Parcels 88Q, 102Q, 106Q-X, OA-08 and OA-15.

The Department agrees with Fort McClellan's proposed level of effort for this phase of the SI. The Department also agrees with Fort McClellan's proposal to compare analytical results with residential human health site-specific screening levels (SSSLs), ecological screening values (ESVs), and established background concentration levels. This data comparison will help Fort McClellan evaluate the potential effects to human and ecological receptors at these sites.

As you are aware, ADEM is in the process of obtaining the services of an Ordnance and Explosive/Unexploded Ordnance (OE/UXO) contractor to provide OE/UXO services to the Department. Because ADEM has not yet secured an OE/UXO contractor, ADEM will not provide comments concerning OE/UXO related activities at this time.
