The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) has reviewed Fort McClellan's *Decision Document and Final Site Investigation Report: Former Rifle/Machine Gun Range, Parcel 98Q*.

The Army submitted the Draft Final Site Investigation (SI) for Parcel 98Q for ADEM review on September 15, 2003. ADEM reviewed this document and submitted comments on May 15, 2006. The main issue addressed in the ADEM review comments was elevated lead concentrations in the soil and seep water. The soil analytical results listed in the Draft Final SI displays elevated lead concentrations ranging from 92.5 to 349 mg/kg, which exceed the ecological screening value (ESV) of 50 mg/kg. During a September 2006 meeting, the BRAC Cleanup Team (BCT) conducted a site visit to observe the current condition of Parcel 98Q. After completing the site visit and following several discussions, the BCT concluded that the maximum concentration of lead in the soil was less than the residential site-specific screening level (SSSL) and that "No Further Action" is appropriate for this site.

ADEM notes that this site is projected for passive recreation reuse by the Army. However, a "No Further Action" and unrestricted land reuse for Parcel 98Q is recommended. ADEM concurs with the Army's recommendation of "No Further Action" and unrestricted land reuse with regard to hazardous, toxic, and radioactive waste (HTRW) related hazardous constituents at the Former Rifle/Machine Gun Range, Parcel 98Q.




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Please note that unexploded ordnance (UXO) matters remain unresolved in this area and will be addressed during ADEM's review of the UXO related work plans and reports for this area.
