
Subject: Final Site-Specific Work Plans for Ft. McClellan

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**Former Fog Oil Storage Area West of the Skeet Range (Parcel 122)**

*General Comments*

1. The Department does not agree with the subsurface soil sampling strategy. Since a comprehensive surface soil screen is being proposed, then we should use it to our advantage. Subsurface soil samples should be taken at locations containing the highest levels of heavy hydrocarbons as indicated from the surface soil screening. Therefore, the surface soil screening must be executed prior to any subsurface soil sampling. If the surface soil screen does not reveal any detections, then the proposed subsurface soil sampling strategy outlined in the draft plan is sufficient. Please revise.
