This is an update bulletin to Navigation Bulletin 14-18. Notice is given to mariners that Jim Woodruff Lock, river mile 106, is now open for all traffic. Repairs to the lower miter gate hydraulic cylinder have been completed.

The lock is currently on summer schedule (Friday through Monday). The lock can be contacted on VHF channels 13 and 16, or 850-663-4692, 8 am - 6 pm Eastern Standard Time on the indicated days. The lock is available twenty four hours per day, seven days per week by appointment only for commercial traffic.
