NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

DREDGE WORK, MILE 410.0, MONTGOMERY POOL

The Inland Dredge KELLY L and associated plant are currently at mile 410.0 on Montgomery Pool. They expect to begin dredging work at that location on April 7, 2017. They will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Navigation traffic can contact the dredge marine channel 16. Work activities will continue at that location for approximately two to three weeks. They will be moving to mile 366.0, Aberdeen Lake at the completion of the work on this area. Traffic is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
