TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

DREDGE WORK, MILE 366.0, ABERDEEN LAKE

Mike Hooks Dredge E STROUD and associated plant has arrived at mile 366.0 on Aberdeen Lake. Dredging activities are currently underway and will continue 24 hours per day, 7 days per week for approximately three weeks. Material will be disposed in the permitted upland disposal area AB-12. Upon completion, the dredge is expected to move downstream to mile marker 326.0 on Aliceville Lake. Navigation traffic may contact the dredge via marine radio on channel 16. Traffic is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
