NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, ALABAMA

DREDGE WORK, MILE 300.0, GAINSEVILLE LAKE

The Inland Dredge KELLY L and associated plant are currently in route to mile 300.0 on Gainesville Lake. They expect to begin dredging work at that location around November 07, 2018, and will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Material will be disposed in the permitted upland disposal area G-21. Work activities will continue at that location for approximately three weeks before advancing downstream to mile 266.0. Navigation traffic can contact the dredge via marine radio on channel 16. Traffic is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
