TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

DREDGE WORK, MILE 326.0 ALICEVILLE LAKE

Mike Hooks Dredge E STROUD and associated plant are preparing to go on tow from mile 366.0, Aberdeen Lake to mile 326.0, Aliceville Lake. They expect to begin dredging work at that location on August 21, 2019, and will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Material will be disposed in the permitted upland disposal area AL-13. Work activities will continue at that location for approximately 10 days before advancing downstream to mile 300.0 on Gainesville Lake. Navigation traffic may contact the dredge via marine radio on channel 16, if needed. Traffic is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
