TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, ALABAMA

DREDGE WORK, MILE 300.0 GAINESVILLE LAKE

Mike Hooks Dredge E **STROUD** and associated plant are preparing to go on tow from mile 326.0, Aliceville Lake to mile 300.0, Gainesville Lake. They expect to begin dredging work at that location on September 02, 2019, and will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Material will be disposed in the permitted upland disposal area G-21. Work activities will continue at that location for approximately 10 days before advancing downstream to mile 288.5 on Gainesville Lake. Navigation traffic may contact the dredge via marine radio on channel 16, if needed. Traffic is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
