NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

EAST BAY AND LAKE WIMICO
GIWW, BAY AND FRANKLIN COUNTIES, FLORIDA

Notice is given to mariners that Carter's Contracting Services, Inc. subcontractor Quality First Marine will begin **mechanical dredging operations of the GIWW in East Bay and Lake Wimico around 07-OCT-2019**. The first assignment, East Bay, is located between miles 309 – 312 and the dredged material will be placed into an upland disposal site located at mile 316 (Overstreet). The Lake Wimico dredging assignment is located between miles 336.5 – 339 and the dredged material will be placed into the upland disposal site located at mile 328 (Gulf County Canal). The contractor's floating plant will include barge-mounted excavators, scows, and tugs to remove the shoaled material, transport, and dispose into the approved upland sites.

Work is expected to be completed in approximately 3 months. The floating plant can be contacted on VHF channels 13 and 16. Mariners should exercise caution when transiting these areas.
