NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

**SUNKEN BARGE, MILE 362.6, ABERDEEN POOL**  
**TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI**

Notice is given to mariners that the M/V MAXX B has reported one of its barges has sank within the navigation channel. The US Coast Guard has been notified and is in contact with the towing vessel and the barge owners, to facilitate its removal from the navigation channel. A Corps survey vessel has been dispatched to collect data on the channel conditions in the area.

**Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting the area. Shipping traffic is urged to contact the M/V MAXX B prior to passing this area. Navigation traffic can contact the vessel via marine radio on channel 16. Traffic is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.**
