Notice is given to mariners that **Jamie Whitten Lock has resumed 24/7 operations and John C. Stennis Lock is now open and has resumed 24/7 operations.** High waters have receded below the respective machinery space elevations at these locks.

Mariners should exercise caution near the locks and dams as high flows will continue until water levels return to normal elevations. All traffic is advised to keep in contact with the respective lock personnel during this time.
