DEMOPOLIS LOCK, MILE 213.2
TOMBIGBEE RIVER, ALABAMA

Reference Navigation Bulletin #20-21

Notice is given to mariners that **Demopolis Lock has resumed daylight hour operations.** High waters have receded below the machinery space elevation at the lock.

Mariners should exercise caution near the locks and dams as high flows will continue until water levels return to normal elevations. All traffic is advised to keep in contact with the respective lock personnel during this time.

The following locks on the Tombigbee River remain closed due to high water:

Coffeerville Lock, mile 116.6
