TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY

Notice to mariners that **the navigation channel at mile marker 357, Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway, is still impassable to traffic.** Also, **there are a number of areas along the waterway with channel restrictions,** where the channel has shoaled to less than authorized dimensions.
