NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

GORGAS STEAM PLANT (MULBERRY FORK)
BLACK WARRIOR RIVER, ALABAMA
RIVER MILES 392.3 AND 398.3

Alabama Power Company will be using a contract crew from *Pike Electric* to perform maintenance on the transmission lines that cross the Black Warrior River (Mulberry Fork) near river mile 398.3 in the vicinity coordinates (Latitude: 33.642, Longitude: -87.201).

This work will commence the morning of 7/15/2019 at 0700 and is expected to be completed by 7/19/2019. Delays to traffic are not anticipated, unless an unforeseen failure occurs. Men will be working aloft on structures on each side of the river.
