NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

ST. GEORGE ISLAND CHANNEL - SIKES CUT

MAINTENANCE DREDGING SIKES CUT

Notice is given to mariners that Inland Dredging Company's cutterhead **Dredge****America** has begun maintenance dredging operations at Sikes Cut. Material will be placed in the approved disposal area located on the east side of Sikes Cut inlet near the eastern jetty. Dredging activities are expected to continue for approximately one month.

Floating and submerged pipeline will be used to complete the work. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
