COFFEEVILLE LOCK AND DAM

Notice is given to mariners that due to the recent heavy rains Coffeeville Lock is experiencing high inflows and outflows through the spillway causing an outdraft hazard. Mariners are to exercise extreme caution when approaching and departing from the lock for at least the next seven (7) days.

CHANNEL BLOCKAGE UPDATE MONTGOMERY POOL, MILE 410.0
