TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

DREDGE WORK, MILE 362.6, ABERDEEN LAKE

Inland Dredging Company's cutterhead dredge AMERICA is expected to finalize work at navigation mile 366.0 on 19 May 2025. Once complete, the dredge will mobilize to navigation mile 362.6. Dredging operations are expected to begin on or around **20 May 2025** and will last approximately **one week**. They will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and will be placing material in the permitted upland disposal area AB-06. Navigation traffic should contact the dredge via marine radio (Channel 16) prior to passing and is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
