NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TOMBIGBEE RIVER, ALABAMA
CLOSURE AT RIVER MILE 173

Notice is given to mariners that the **Tombigbee River** will be closed at **River Mile 173** (Naheola Railroad Bridge) will be in the closed position starting **Sunday, 25 January at 1700 until further notice** due to extreme weather conditions. The bridge will be lowered in the closed position and will be reassessed for operations at **0900 on Monday, 26 January**.

In addition, due to recent heavy rains, Coffeerville Lock is experiencing high inflows and outflows through the spillway causing an outdraft hazard. Mariners are urged to exercise extreme caution when approaching and departing from the lock.
