TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

DELAYS AT THAD COCHRAN LOCK AND DAM, RIVER MILE 371.1

Notice is given to mariners that the United States Army Corps of Engineers Engineer Research and Development Center (ERDC) will be performing a Submerged Infrastructure Inspection Challenge at Thad Cochran Lock and Dam, Tennessee Tombigbee Waterway, Mile 371.1. The participants of the challenge will have access to the lock Monday – Friday from 0800 – 1700, beginning 13 July extending through 7 August.

Mariners transiting this reach may experience delays, but every effort will be made to minimize impacts on navigational traffic. Users should contact the lock during this period to receive an update on the status of the work and the possibility of any delays.
