NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

APALACHICOLA, CHATTAHOOCHEE AND FLINT RIVER SYSTEM
(ACF)

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will conclude the 2024 navigation season on the ACF and suspend water releases to support a 7-foot navigation channel beginning on April 30, 2024. Current hydrological conditions, meteorological forecasts, and basin-wide modeling do not support the extension of the navigation season beyond April. A 7.4-foot Blountstown gage is needed to provide a 7-foot channel on the Apalachicola River. River stages for the ACF system can be viewed at:
