NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI
DREDGE WORK, MILE 320.0, ALICEVILLE LAKE

Reference Navigation Bulletin 24-55:

Inland Dredging Company's cutterhead dredge AMERICA and associated fleet have completed work at 366.0 (Aberdeen Lake) and are prepping to mobilize to mile 320.0 (Aliceville Lake). Operations are expected to begin on or around **9 August 2024** and will last approximately **one week**. They will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and will be placing material in the permitted upland disposal area AL-09 located on the left-descending bank. Navigation traffic should contact the dredge via marine radio (Channel 16) prior to passing and is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
