NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

DREDGE WORK, MILE 329.0, ALICEVILLE LAKE

Inland Dredging Company's cutterhead dredge RANGER and associated fleet are mobilizing to navigation mile 329.0 on Aliceville Lake. Dredging operations are expected to begin on or around **25 August 2024** and will last approximately **two weeks**. They will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and will be placing material in the permitted upland disposal area AL-14. Navigation traffic should contact the dredge via marine radio (Channel 16) prior to passing and is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
