NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

**TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, ALABAMA**  
**DREDGE WORK, MILE 266.0, DEMOPOLIS LAKE**

*Inland Dredging Company's* cutterhead dredge AMERICA and associated fleet have completed work at 320.0 (Aliceville Lake) and are prepping to mobilize to mile 266.0 (Demopolis Lake). Operations are expected to begin on or around **27 August 2024** and will last approximately **one week**. They will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and will be placing material in the permitted upland disposal area D-36 located on the right-descending bank. Navigation traffic should contact the dredge via marine radio (Channel 16) prior to passing and is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
