NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

PASCAGOULA HARBOR, MISSISSIPPI

DREDGING OPERATIONS

Notice is given to mariners that Mike Hooks, LLC's pipeline dredge *E. Stroud* is performing maintenance dredging operations in Pascagoula Federal Navigation Channel near Red Beacon 10. The dredge is placing material in approved open water placement areas adjacent to the channel. Channel dredging is expected to be completed on or around 30 August 2024. The dredge will then transition to the Jackson County Port Authority's Bayou Casotte Terminal Facilities. Material will be placed in the Greenwood Beneficial Use Site. Dredging activities are expected to continue for approximately two months. The dredge can be contacted on VHF Channels 13 and 16.
