NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, ALICEVILLE LAKE, MS

SCHEDULED TEMPORARY CHANNEL OBSTRUCTION ALICEVILLE LAKE, RIVER MILE 331.4

Notice is given to mariners that *Canal Barge Company* will be rolling cargo off barges at West Lowndes Landing near river mile 331.4 (right-descending bank). Offloading operations are expected to begin at **0700** and conclude at **1500** on **October 1, 2024**. The tow will extend approximately 330-ft into the waterway from the west bank and will remain stationary for the duration of the roll-off.

Mariners are requested to exercise caution while traversing the area and commercial vessels are urged to refrain from passing until offloading is complete.
