NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

DREDGE WORK, MILE 326.0, ALICEVILLE LAKE

Inland Dredging's Dredge KELLY L and associated fleet are currently on site at mile 326.0, Aliceville Lake. Dredging operations will begin on or around 11 August 2020 and will last approximately two weeks. They will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week and material will be disposed in the permitted upland disposal area AL-13 adjacent to the channel. Navigation traffic can contact the dredge via marine radio on channel 16. Traffic is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
