NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

DREDGE WORK, MILE 357.5 COLUMBUS LAKE

The Coastal Dredging dredge **COASTAL ROSE** and associated plant are preparing to go on tow from Jackson, Alabama, to river mile 357.5, Columbus Lake, Tennessee Tombigbee Waterway. They expect to begin dredging work at that location on or around October 08, 2019, and will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Material will be disposed in the permitted upland disposal area C-21. Work activities will continue at that location for approximately 14 days before advancing upstream to mile 410.0 on Montgomery Pool. Navigation traffic may contact the dredge via marine radio on channel 16, if needed. Traffic is requested to transit this reach with caution at no wake speed.
