TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Mobile District requests your review and comment on the proposed Old Oliver Lock and Dam Land Sale and Lease, Black-Warrior and Tombigbee Waterway, Tuscaloosa, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama. A copy of the environmental assessment is located on the following website: https://www.sam.usace.army.mil/Missions/Planning-Environmental/Environmental-Assessments/. The document is being circulated to resource agencies and interested members of the public for a 15-day comment period.

The proposed Old Oliver Lock and Dam Land Sale and Lease consists of the sale of 6.37 acres of the Old Oliver Lock site and leasing an adjoining 6.07-acre portion of the Oliver Dam Public Use Area (also referred to as the Oliver Spillway Fishing Pier Park) which includes a 2.15-acre access road easement to the City of Tuscaloosa. Early coordination with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Georgia Department of Natural Resources and the Georgia State Historic Preservation Officer is complete.
