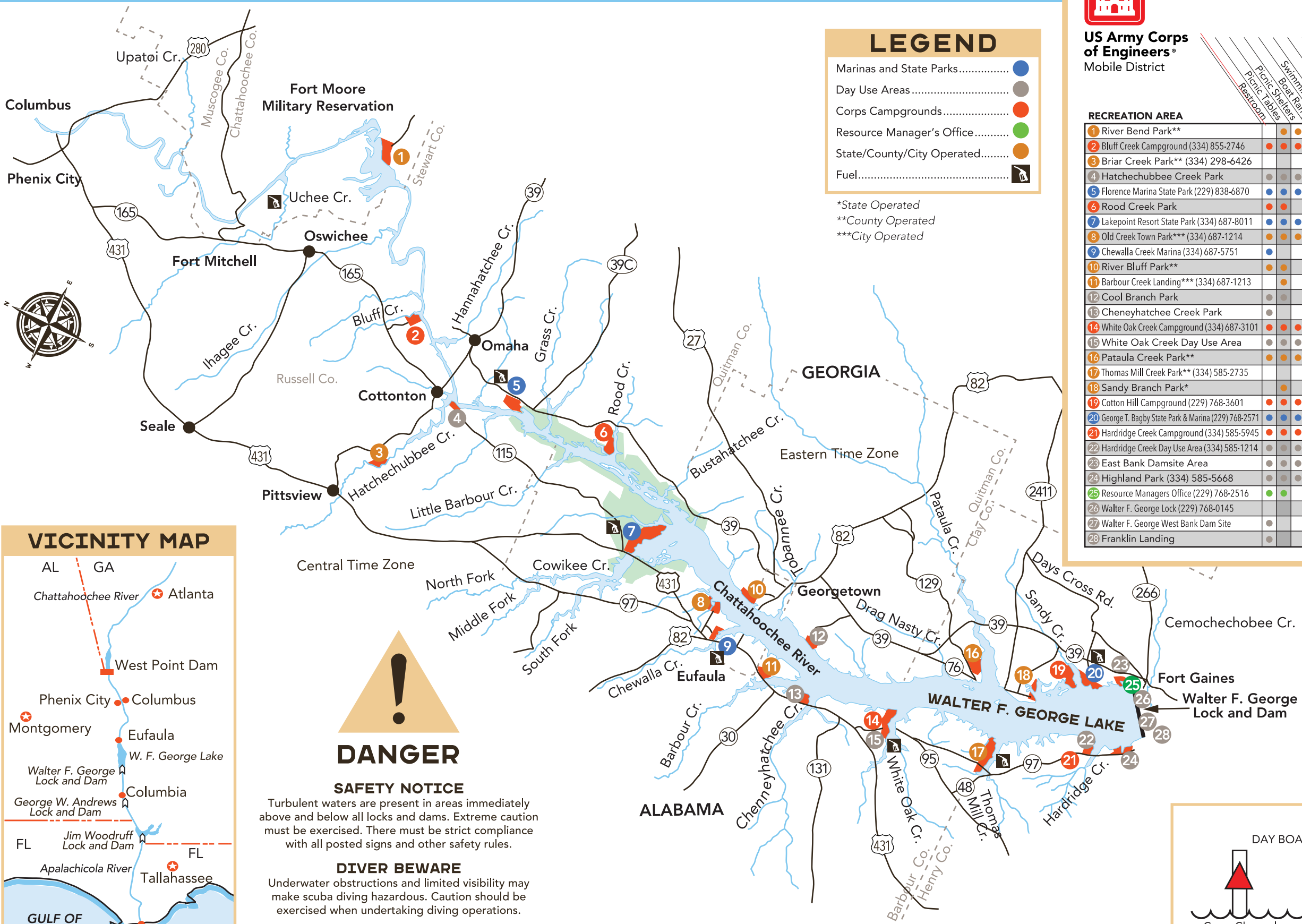

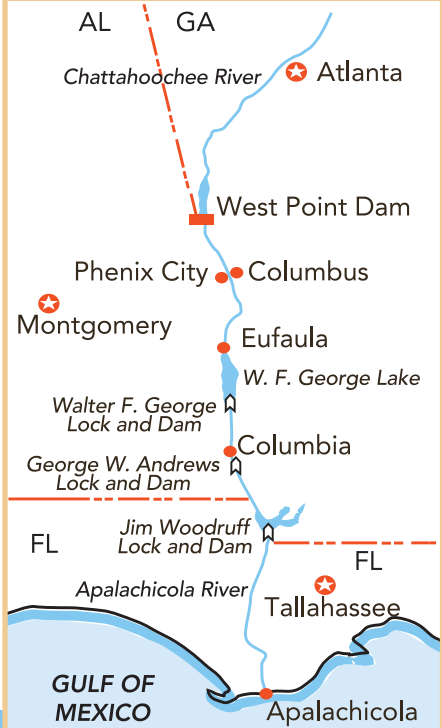

Turbulent waters are present in areas immediately above and below all locks and dams. Extreme caution must be exercised. There must be strict compliance with all posted signs and other safety rules.

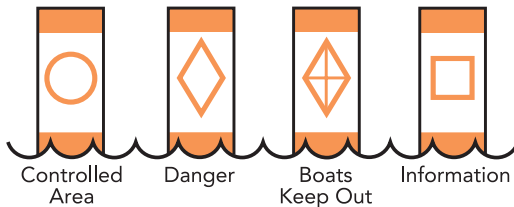
DIVER BEWARE

Underwater obstructions and limited visibility may make scuba diving hazardous. Caution should be exercised when undertaking diving operations.

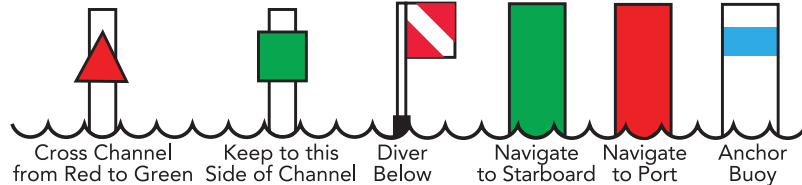
STANDARD RESERVOIR MARKINGS

REMEMBER THESE RULES

- Overtaking/Passing:** Boat being passed has the right-of-way. Keep Clear.
- Meeting Head On:** Keep to the right.
- Crossing:** Boat on right has the right-of-way. Slow down and permit him to pass.

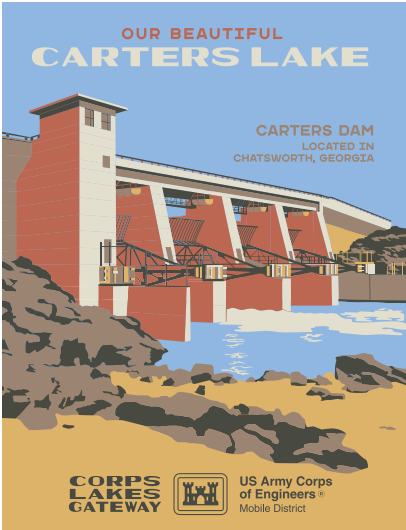
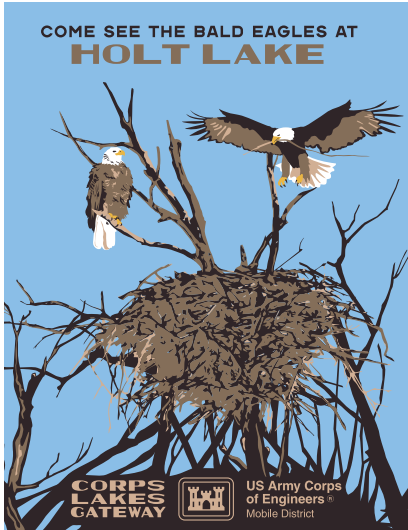
These two Chattahoochee River Lakes offer a host of recreational and sporting opportunities to the millions of people who visit each year. Although the lakes were built to provide navigation and hydroelectric power, the emphasis is on family fun. Camping and fishing are the most popular activities at the lakes, but many folks come just to spend the day swimming, picnicking, sunning or playing ball along the shore. Visitors to the area may also want to tour some of the historic homes in nearby towns, or visit nearby state parks such as Kolomoki Mounds State Park, which contains the largest Indian mound east of the Mississippi River. - SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**
- We hope you enjoy your visit to Walter F. George and George W. Andrews Lakes whether you come to camp, fish, relax on the beach or stroll through the woods. For your safety and that of others, please take time to look over the following list of safety precautions.
1. Be alert to underwater hazards and low-hanging power lines when boating.
 2. Keep children under close supervision especially near the water.
 3. Wear personal flotation devices when on or near the water.
 4. File a trip plan with someone, advising them of your whereabouts and when you plan to return.
 5. Swim at your own risk in designated swimming areas only. Do not swim in areas marked no swimming.
 6. When downstream of the dam, be prepared to leave the area immediately for higher ground upon hearing the warning horn.

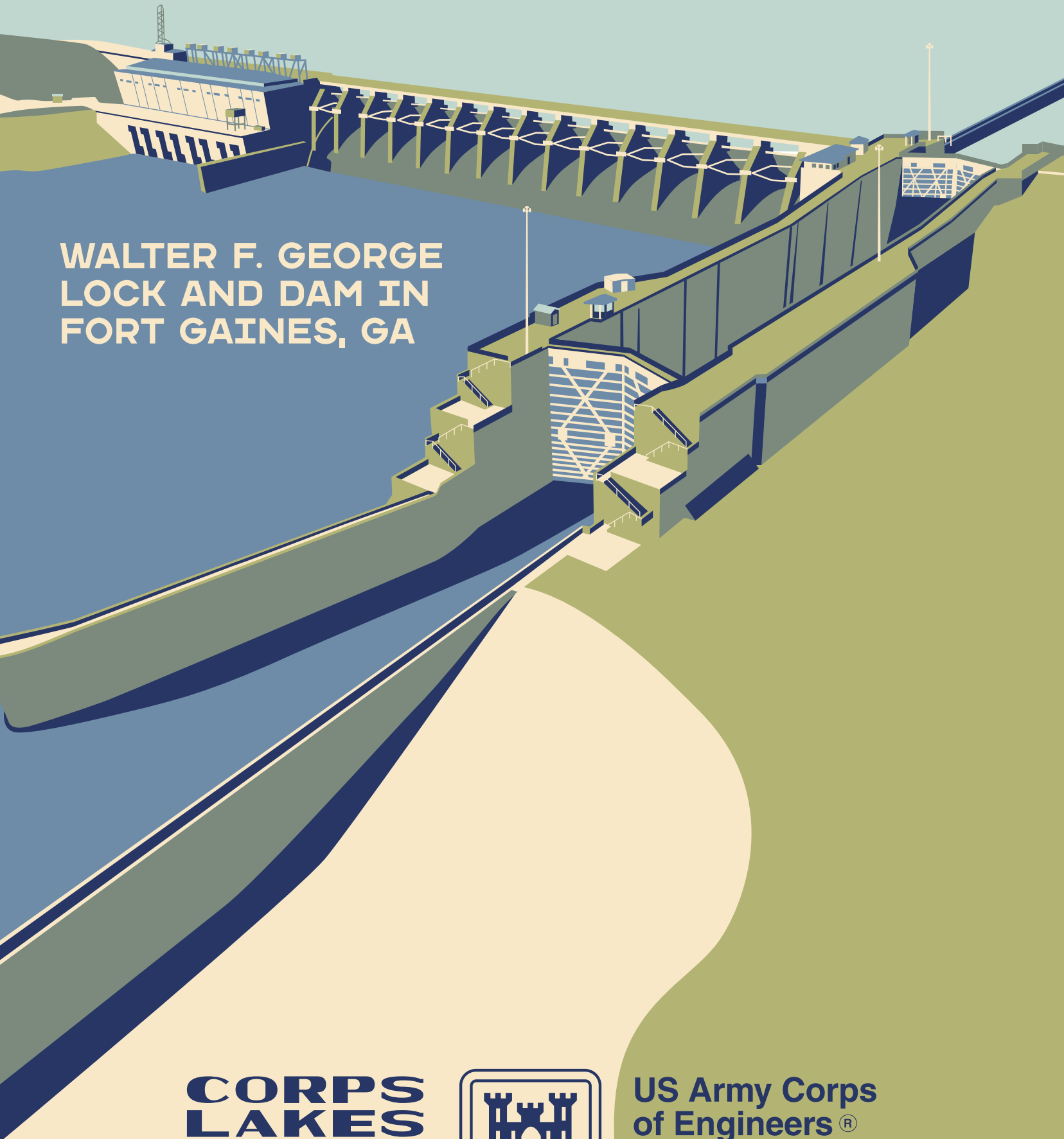
