DOLL MOUNTAIN CAMPGROUND INFORMATION

Doll Mountain Campground has 51 campsites and a group camping area. Electric and water hookups are provided at 37 sites, and one (1) is tent only. The remaining 14 campsites and group camping area are primitive and have no electric or water hookups. Campers must reserve campsites by calling 877-444-6777 or online at www.recreation.gov.

Campers may utilize two (2) comfort stations furnished with showers and one (1) vault toilet located near the group camping area. A playground is also located within the campground. Boaters may launch from a boat ramp within the park.

The campground is open from April through October.

CARTERS LAKE BASIC CAMPGROUND RULES

Quiet hours are in effect from 10 pm until 6 am.

Check-in time: 4:00 pm -early check-in possible if site vacant

Check-out time 3:00 pm- Off site and out of campground.

Campground entrance gate will be open from: 9 A.M. - 10 P.M. Friday-Saturday & Holidays

9 A.M. - 9 P.M. Sunday-Thursday

Campsite occupancy is limited to maximum of <u>eight (8) people and three (3) vehicles (includes any water vessels, trailers, or</u> associated equipment).

Campers may exit the park at any time after gate closure by using the electronic gate. No camper vehicles are permitted to re-enter the park after gate closing times.

Camping is limited to maximum of 14 days during 30 day period and campers must display camping permit at campsite marker.

Keep campsites clean and deposit all garbage in the dumpster located at boat ramp.

Camping off impact areas or in undesignated areas is prohibited.

Washing vehicles, camping equipment or anything that produces gray water to be discharged is prohibited.

All motorized vehicles must be street legal, operated by licensed driver and only on authorized roadways.

All pets must be penned, caged, or on a leash no longer than six feet. Vicious pets are not allowed.

Fireworks, firearms, explosives or other projectile firing devices are prohibited.

Protect natural resources by hanging lanterns on holders and using only dead wood for campfires.

Feeding/Harassment of wildlife is prohibited.

All swimming is at your own risk, use extreme caution. See gate attendant for information about life jacket loaner program.

Individuals may be required to furnish proper identification to Park Rangers.
