\boxtimes	The review area is comprised entirely of dry land (i.e., there are no waters or water features, including
	wetlands, of any kind in the entire review area). Rationale: The project will occur in a highly disturbed
	parcel which is located within a larger parcel owned by the applicant. The jurisdictional determination
	was requested for the region along previously disturbed and filled areas of a pre-existing golf course
	(as shown on the attached aerial map as red and orange pathways within the parcel). The requested
	review area exists only within the existing disturbed and filled areas within the golf course fairway, and
	any proposed work will be located within the previously disturbed pathways. Predominant soils within
	these existing pathways are non-hydric and well drained Fuquay loamy sand (80%) profile. The review
	area is bordered on the east and west ends by undeveloped natural areas with soils indicative of
	stream terraces and toeslopes and an isolated pond located in the central southern area, but as
	previously discussed, all proposed work will be conducted within the existing disturbed golf course
	development. Additionally, the FEMA flood database shows the entire review area as located within
	Zone X, or minimal flood hazard.
