B. REQUIRED ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD. EXPLAIN RATIONALE FOR DETERMINATION THAT THE REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND: Based on review of information provided on behalf of the City of Valley by the East Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission (EARPCD) and other available desktop resources including Web Soil Survey mapping, USGS topographic mapping, and aerial photography the up to 0.9-acre JD review area consists of upland/non-wetland, dry lands. Documentation reviewed demonstrates the JD review area and additional surrounding land was cleared of trees and graded as early as 1950 and has since been maintained primarily as mowed land associated with a small city airfield and an open space park area. The approximately 0.9-acre review area lacks any wetlands, tributaries, or drainage features.
