B. REQUIRED ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD. EXPLAIN RATIONALE FOR DETERMINATION THAT THE

REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND: Based on review of available desktop resources including Web Soil Survey mapping, USGS topographic mapping, aerial photography, and current site-specific photos, the JD review area consists of upland/non-wetland, dry lands. Aerial photography shows the area that would be impacted by the proposed detention pond to be located within the partially developed residential plot at the intersection of East Railroad Avenue and Edwards Street in Cullman County, which is a dry land area. Desktop resources evaluated also indicate the JD review area lacks any streams or tributary features. Older topographic mapping appears to indicate a tributary historically flowed diagonally across the extreme northwest corner of the property; however, review of available historic aerial photography demonstrates that the feature was channelized and entirely removed from the property by re-routing around the property in man-made road side and railroad drainage ditching at some time between 1975 and 1997 and a residential homestead established on the property by 2006.
