REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND: Based on review of available desktop resources including Web Soil Survey mapping, USGS topographic mapping, aerial photography, and current site-specific photos, the JD review area consists of upland/non-wetland, dry lands. Aerial photography shows the identified 9-acre review parcel to consist of an undeveloped, agricultural row crop land dry land area at the corner of Mt. View Road and Highway 144 in Calhoun County. Desktop resources evaluated also indicate the JD review area lacks any streams or tributary features.
